## Early Bird Entry Closes 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2015

Make sure you take advantage of the Early Bird Entry Fees for the Hi-Tec Oils Bathurst 6 Hour. ONLY \$5,500 (incl GST) if fully completed entries and fees are received prior to the 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2015. If you require a tax invoice prior to paying, entries MUST be received by the 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2015 for an invoice to be generated and sent to the competitor in time for payment to be made by the 30<sup>th</sup>.

Early Bird Fee - \$5,500 GST inclusive  
(paid in full before October 30th) .

Standard Entry Fee - \$6,600 GST inclusive

Competitors who fail to pay their entry fee in full by 28 Feb 16 will incur a late administration fee of \$1,100 GST inclusive

## Licence Requirements

All Australian drivers must hold a minimum of a CAMS Clubman Circuit (CC) Licence.  
 All New Zealand drivers must hold as a minimum of a MSNZ C1 or C2 licence with a Trans-Tasman Visa. All New Zealand drivers with an international licence do not require a Trans-Tasman Visa.  
 All international drivers must hold a minimum of the highest grade national licence issued by the ASN, plus complete a CAMS 'Foreign Participation Visa' application – available on [www.bathurstmotorfestival.com.au](http://www.bathurstmotorfestival.com.au) website and send this to CAMS 10 days prior to the event.  
 Minimum of two (2) and maximum of three (3) drivers per car.

## Camping at Bathurst

The 2016 Bathurst Motor Festival will operate the Paddock Campground (bottom of the circuit behind the Pit Complex). The booking system is now automated with advance bookings only available online. Teams will require a VISA or Mastercard to complete their transaction. Advance bookings are now open and sites will be available at the Event, pending availability.

The campground will open **9am on Wednesday 23 March** and close at **8am Monday 28 March 2016**.  
 Sites will be pre-sold for \$80 per site, and at the Event for \$100 per site (depending on availability).  
 All sites will be line-marked and measure approximately 8m x 8m. Only one vehicle (includes motorcycle) permitted per site.  
 There are no powered sites available in this Campground, however teams are welcome to bring generators.  
 Campground sites can only be booked and paid for online.  
 Camping is not permitted at the event anywhere other than the designated campgrounds.
