Reminder

(1.10.2) Entries close 19th Feb, 2016

As per Supplementary Regulations page 6

1.10.6.2 Competitors who submit an entry form and pay in full after 30th October 2015 and before 28th February 2016 the entry fee will be \$6,600 GST inclusive.

1.10.6.3 Competitors who fail to pay their entry fee in full by 28th February 2016 will incur a late administration fee of \$1,100.

1.10.6.4 Any competitor for which the entry fees have not been received in full, including any late administration fees, will not be permitted to participate in the Event.

Licence Requirements

A reminder for all drivers – you must hold a minimum of a CAMS Clubman Circuit (CC) licence to compete at Mount Panorama, Bathurst.

NO provisional (PC) licences are permitted to compete at this circuit.

Any New Zealand drivers must contact MSNZ to check that their licence is valid.

All International drivers that hold a licence issued by another ASN must purchase a CAMS foreign participation visa to compete. If you hold an Australian passport and live overseas, you will need to contact CAMS for an authority to compete.
